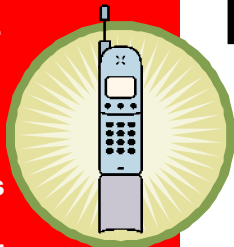

The best way to reach us during this month will still be our cell phone 404.313-0943.



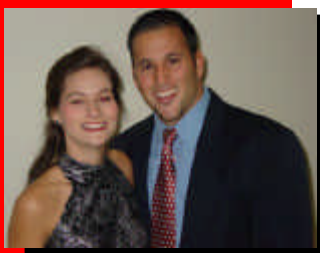
## What is Next ...
